SUPERSPRAY ADHESIVE

DESCRIPTION

Superspray Adhesive is general purpose DCM free aerosol adhesive.

USES

It has been designed for the fixing of Carpet Tiles, Foam Backed Carpets, Polyurethane-Backed Carpets, Foam and Paper Underlays, Felts, Textiles and Fabrics to Wood Stone, Tiles, Concrete, Plaster and Brickwork. Not suitable for expanded polystyrene, Vinyls & Linoleum. For Vinyls & Linoleum, use Stikatak Vinyl Spray Adhesive (\$730). Not suitable for conditions where temperatures exceed 50°C

STORAGE

Superspray Adhesive must be stored at a moderate temperature. Keep container in a well ventilated area and away from sources of ignition.

APPLICATION

- · Surfaces to be joined must be free from dust and grease.
- Shake can before use, spray approx. 15 -20cm (6-8 inches) from one or both surfaces.
- One- way system Spray one surface, leave to dry for 1 minute until tacky and press into position.
- Two- way system sprays both surfaces and allow to dry for 2-5 minutes before bonding (Always invert can and spray to clear nozzle).

COVERAGE

3 – 4 m² per 500ml can.

WARNING

Do not ingest. Avoid skin contact. Use in well ventilated areas. In case of accident wash eyes and sensitive skin with clean cold water. If irritation persists take medical advice. Keep away from children and pets. Do not empty into drains.

PRECAUTIONS

- Extremely Flammable
- Keep away from sources of ignition
- No Smoking
- In case of poor ventilation use suitable respiratory equipment
- Pressurised container Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures greater than 50°C
- Do not pierce or burn even after use
- Do not spray on naked flame or any incandescent material
